In 1987, a small group of people from the Escanaba Community met to create the Friends of the Escanaba Public Library. The creation of this organization, fully established in January of 1988, was born of a need to help the Library in a time of crisis. Since then it has become an active group of people who volunteer their time to support the work of the Library.

The Friends of the Library is a non-profit organization open to everyone regardless of gender, race, religion, disability, age or place of residence. It does not involve itself in Library policy and is governed by its own board. The Board meets once a month to discuss Library needs, support new events and to determine the best way of helping the Library and community.

- Support children's programs such as the summer reading program and Christmas with Santa
- Annual Ice Cream Social which includes a City Band performance
- Annual Book sale and maintenance of the Used Book Sale room
- Sponsorship of the community reading programs
- Contribute to the purchase of books and other lending materials, book display racks, movie license and computers
- Maintenance of the Nancy Devlin Kennedy Memorial Garden
