Recall Forum

The Delta County League of Women Voters (DCLWV) in partnership with the American Association of University Women (AAUW) announce a candidate forum for the upcoming Delta County Commissioner Recall Election on April 23, 2024, 7 p.m. at the Escanaba City Hall.

Due to the special nature of a recall election and space limitations, the forum will be closed to the public. LWV and AAUW recognize the high interest in this election and are providing public participation in other ways.

The public will be able to live-stream the forum on Spectrum channel 191, as well as on the City of Escanaba website <https://www.youtube.com/@cityofescanaba2710/streams>. In addition, the forum will be recorded and posted to the League's face book page www.facebook.com/DeltaCountyLeagueofWomenVoters and website www.lwvdeltacounty.org.

We will conduct this forum in our normal manner. Introductions by the moderator, open and closing remarks and one-minute responses. The normal rules will apply for the candidates.

We will be actively watching for questions during the forum. Our screeners will be onsite to view the questions and submit them for responses as is our normal procedure.

Whether you vote in person or by absentee ballot, do not forget to vote on May 7. The polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. No early voting is available as this is a local special election.
